

RESOURCE IDEAS FOR CHURCHES & INDIVIDUALS

When London hosts the world-famous Olivier Awards on Sunday April 9th, churches, cell groups and individuals will be lifting the arts professions heavenwards. The world will be watching...and believers will be praying!

Here are some ideas on how you or your church can be involved...

- 1. **Pray for an individual** working in the Arts & Entertainment.
 - ♣ This could be somebody from your favourite film or TV series or somebody in the news.
 - ♣ As well as performers, don't forget to pray for Producers, Writers, Directors and other influential professionals.
 - **♣** Remember the Designers and Artists responsible for those eyecatching creations.
- 2. **Encourage your church** to remember and pray for the Arts & Entertainment, perhaps as part of a service by:
 - ♣ Presenting a piece of Drama, Dance, Poetry or Music
 - ♣ Inviting an artiste to perform or be interviewed we have placed some ideas of who you could invite below
 - ♣ Holding an exhibition of paintings, sculptures, photographs or textiles, or perhaps a workshop in your church
 - Creating a PowerPoint presentation or slide show by screening one of the short celebrity interview videos or a simple slide show using the prayer and some images - all downloadable from the sites below
 - ♣ Simply using the Arts & Entertainment Sunday Prayer as below, either as a communal or individual prayer

- Put a news item or short interview piece in your church bulletin or notice board


Help us remember that the beauty, loveliness and gentleness of your character is represented by the world around us and expressed in the skills of those in the arts and entertainment professions.

DANA - International Singing Star DANA celebrates 40 years in the business with an evening of music, laughter and faith! DAD`s ARMY – An Evening with Frank Williams one of the best-known faces in the most popular classic comedy television series ever made, and appears in the new feature film. Even after thirty years, the BBC`s *Dad's Army* continues to regularly pull in millions of viewers for each repeated episode. Some churches have even encouraged a themed event with afternoon tea, or a wartime supper and fancy costume! Frank`s private and un-aired footage of the *Dad`s Army* cast is included where the church has the technical facilities, and has been very popular with all age audiences. **JANEY LEE GRACE**, known to millions as Steve Wright`s daily sidekick on BBC Radio Two`s primetime week day show, also enjoys her own regular BBC shows alongside presenting *Sunday Love Songs* and *Friday Night Is Music Night*. Janey has toured with George Michael, Wham!, Boy George and Kim Wilde and enjoyed a top ten hit in 1992 as lead singer with *7 Ways To Love*. Her best-selling book *Imperfectly Natural* has spawned several new editions and a popular website. She sings and chats about her work and Christian faith.

JIMMY CRICKET is a rare breed of `clean` comedians and so is perfect for a special church-based laughter event. From his ITV and BBC series to *The Royal Variety Performance* Jimmy is always in constant demand and he recently enjoyed yet another smash hit summer season at home and abroad.

SYD LITTLE, **one half of legendary comedy duo** *Little & Large*, recently featured on BBCTV's *Masterchef*, ITV's *Ant & Dec*'s *Takeaway*, *Cash in the Attic, Big Brother* and Granada TV's *Trust Me I'm A Holiday Rep*, is celebrating 50 years of show business and touring churches with his Gospel show which has proved extremely popular across the UK..

HEAVENS JUKEBOX – **An evening of original 60`s music!** Stars from some of the UK`s top bands invite you to join them for an explosive mix of stunning music and great stories as Churches across the UK rock to the sounds of the sixties! The latest evangelistic opportunity is now available to many more churches across the UK as some of the country's leading band members from the solid gold sixties re-unite. Musicians from various bands including Hermans Hermits, ELO, The Beatles, Cliff Richard, Lonnie Donnegan, Gene Vincent and `one-hit wonders`. The evenings or afternoons with DANA, *Dads Army* 's Frank Williams, Janey Lee Grace, Jimmy Cricket, Syd Little or Heavens Jukebox consists of much laughter, great music and cringe-free chat about the effect that God has had on their personal and commercial lives. They often draw a good crowd, are frequently self-funding even by charging low ticket prices and can be used as a celebration event, an outreach or as an introduction to an Alpha Supper. This selection of light-hearted events are designed to have a wide appeal across the age ranges and can be enjoyed by all ages and backgrounds and are ideal for those who don't normally attend church. Each event is self-standing and personally hosted by myself or one of my experienced colleagues.
